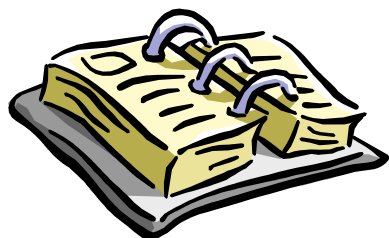

All very positive for the future development of our junior cricketers.

The junior indoor nets were all very well attended at Accrington Academy, starting in February and all through March, the first outside net was cancelled due to the very cold weather and ground conditions, however the last 3 Thursday evenings have again been well attended with all our juniors enjoying some early season sunshine, long may it continue!!

Our under 11s played the first game on the W.E.C.G on Monday 19th against Rishton in the cup, for the majority of our players it was their first game.
